Saturday March 12.

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from N.E. the watch
employed stowing Wood and Water and
Painting the Larboard watch on Liberty
Middle part squally Latter part. at
Ten Mr Roberts came on board and
held a meeting attended by the crews
of the vessels in Port so ends

Sunday March 13.

This day comes in with light rain squalls
wind from E.N.E. Middle and Latter
pleasant so ends

Monday March 14.

This day comes in with Pleasant weather
and light wind from N.E. all hands
employed getting and stowing Wood
and water. Middle and Latter part
Pleasant so ends

Tuesday March 15

This day comes in with Pleasant weather
and strong wind from E.N.E. all
Ready for sea by the first fair wind
Middle and Latter part Pleasant
so ends

Wednesday March 16

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from N.E. at One
got under weigh at Two the Pilot
left Board forward steering S by E
with all sail set. The bark Swallow
and Frances Honeretter came out
the same time Middle part steering N by E
at One steering S.S.E. Latter part steering S.E.
under reefs so ends No Obs.

To the Line 2 Voy age March 1857.

Thursday March 17.

This day comes in with rain and squally
weather steering S.E. under reefs. wind
from N.E. Middle and Latter part the
same so ends. Lat 3.15 N

Friday March 18. Lon 159.27 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and strong wind from E.N.E. heading
S.E. under reefs Middle and Latter part
the same so ends No Obs.

Saturday March 19

This day comes in with squally weather
and strong wind from N.E. steering S.E.
under reefs Middle and Latter part
the same so ends Lat 1.35 N

Sunday March 20 Lon 160.14 E

This day comes in with thick weather and
light wind from N.W. steering S.E. under
reefs Middle part the same Latter part
pleasant with all sail set so ends 0.33 S

Monday March 21. Lon 160.33 E

This day comes in with squally weather
wind from E heading S.S.E. with the
light Reels furled. Middle part under
reefs Latter part with all sail set heading
E.S.E. so ends No Obs

Tuesday March 22.

This day comes in with rain and calm.
Middle and Latter part rain and squally
wind from W steering E.N.E. so ends Lat 0.54 S
Lon 161.25 E
