Wednesday June 22.

This day comes in with pleasant weather and
and light wind from N. heading E. S. E. with
the light sails furled stowing Oil.
Middle part heading E. S. E. Latter part
heading N. E. ends

Thursday June 23. Lon 173.43 E
Lat 2.01 S

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light air from E heading N. N. E. with
all sail set. Middle part heading N.
Latter part heading N. by E. so ends at 1.00 P

Friday June 24. Lon 173.56 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from E. N. E. heading N.
with all sail set. Middle part steering
N. by W. Tacked at One and at Three
Latter part at day light saw Henderson
Island. at Ten the Natives came on board
with Coconuts and fowls at Eleven the
Natives left and kept of for Woodlee
Island so ends

Saturday June 25 Lon 173.28 E
Lat 0.08 N

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from E. S. E. steering S.
westward for Woodlee Island at eleven
the Natives came on board at four the
Natives left braced forward heading N. by W.
with all sail set. Look William Swain
from Woodlee Island so land him at
some other Island that Middle part
steering S. E. by S under short sail
at Four tacked to N. Latter part heading
N. E. ends

Lon 173.28 E

On the Line & Voyage June 1859
Sunday June 26

This day comes in with pleasant weather and
light wind from E steering N. with all
sail set (Woodlee Island in sight from mast
head Middle part steering S. at one
more ship to N. Latter part steering N.
at Curlew Halls Island bearing N. W.
six miles distance so ends No Obs.

Monday June 27.

This day comes in with pleasant weather and
light wind from E steering S. westward
for Halls Islands at Three one canoe
came along side from the Island at half
past three the canoe left and took
William Swain on shore from half three
steering S. Middle part steering N. by W. under
short sail Latter part steering the same the
watch employed repairing the main top
sail so ends

Tuesday June 28 Lon 172.26 E
Lat 0.03 S

This day comes in with pleasant weather and
light wind from E steering N. by W. with all sail
set. Middle part heading S. E. under reef
Latter part heading N. by W. with the light
sails furled so ends

Wednesday June 29 Lon 172.01 E
Lat 0.07 S

This day comes in with pleasant weather and
strong wind from E. N. E. heading N. with
the light sails furled Middle part Tacked
at Ten to E under reef Latter part heading
S. E. with part of the light sails set
the watch repairing the fore top sail
so ends
