Thursday Jan 26.

This day comes in with pleasant weather and strong wind from E heading S.S.E. with the light sails furled, Middle part heading N under reefs Latter part steering S with all sail set. at Twelve Curtis Rocks bearing E five miles distant so ends this day No Uts.

Friday Jan 27.

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from N steering S with all sail set. Middle part heading N under reefs Latter part with all sail set so ends Lat 30 44 S

Saturday Jan 28. Lon 179.52 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from N.N.W. heading S.W. with part of the light sails set. Middle part under short sail Latter part steering N with the light sails furled so ends this day Lat 30.52 S

Sunday Jan 29. Lon 178.48 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from E steering N with the light sails furled. Middle and Latter part blowing a light gale from E heading S under storm sails so ends Lat 30 47 S

Monday Jan 30. Lon 178.08 E

This day comes in with thick weather blowing a gale from E heading S under storm sails Middle and Latter part the same so ends Lat 31.05 S

Tuesday Jan 31.

This day comes in with pleasant weather and blowing a gale from E heading S under storm sails Middle and Latter part the same so ends 100 Uts.

Wednesday Feb 1.

This day comes in with rain and thick weather blowing a gale from E heading S under storm sails Middle and Latter part the same so ends 31.23 S

Thursday Feb 2. Lon 176.14 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather blowing a gale from S.E. heading S.S.W. under storm sails Middle and Latter part the same so ends Lat 31.12 S

Friday Feb 3. Lon 175.31 E

This day comes in with thick weather blowing a light gale from E heading S under storm sails Middle and Latter part the same so ends Lat 31.26 S

Saturday Feb 4. Lon 174.57 E

This day comes in blowing a light gale from E heading S under storm sails Middle part the same Latter part strong wind with reef top sails and fore sail set. so ends Lat 32.01 S

Sunday Feb 5. Lon 174.38 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and strong wind from E heading S.S.E. under reefs. Middle part the same Latter part heading N.E. so ends Lat 31.51 S
