Saturday March 31

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from N.W. steering E with all sail set Middle and Latter part steering N.E. so Ends Lat 33.55

Sunday April 1. Lon 179.57 E

This day comes in with Calm. Middle part the same Latter part strong wind from E heading N.N.E. under reef so Ends Lat 33.43

Monday April 2. Lon 179.19 E

This day comes in with strong wind from E heading N.N.E. with four sails and reef main top sail set Middle part under short sail Latter part light wind heading N.E. with all sail set seven sails in sight so Ends 33.26

Tuesday April 3. Lon 179.42 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from E.S.E. heading N.E. with all sail set at six spoke the Bark Traveled Middle part under reef Latter part with all sail set heading S so Ends Lat 33.19

Wednesday Apr 4. Lon 179.40 E

This day comes in with light wind from E heading S.S.E. with all sail set Middle and Latter part under reef thick fog so Ends No Obs.

Thursday April 5.

This day comes in with fog and light wind from N.W. steering E under reef. Middle part heading N.E. Latter part strong wind heading S.S.E. so Ends Lat 34.18 Lon 179.25

Friday April 6.

This day comes in with wind from E heading S.E. under reef. Middle part the same Latter part steering N.W. so Ends Lat 34.10 S

Saturday April 7. Lon 179.57 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and strong wind from E steering N.W. under reef. Middle part under storm sails Latter part heading N under reef so Ends Lat 32.55 S

Sunday April 8. Lon 179.29 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and strong wind from E.N.E. heading N.W. under reef. Middle part heading E.S.E. Latter part heading S so Ends Lat 32.46 S

Monday April 9. Lon 179.02 E

This day comes in with thick weather and light wind from E.S.E. heading S with part of the light sails set. Middle part under reef Latter part heading E.N.E. with the light sails furled so Ends Lat 33.17 S

Tuesday April 10 Lon 179.26 E

This day comes in with squally weather and strong wind from S.E. heading N.E. under reef. Middle part under storm sails Latter part heading S.E. so Ends Lat 32.47 S
