Bosley Island. Saw land birds Lat 2.40 S Long 126.10 E

Thursday November 11. 1841

Three 24 hours light breeze and calm from the S to S W steering E half S
W saw Sufferbottom Lat 2.26 S Long 126.30 E do ends

Friday November 12. 1841

Three 24 hours light breeze and calm steering E saw ~~the~~
Sperm Whales Leased for Boats. Saw a shark and Ser 3 or
Lat 2.18 S Long 126.50 E

Saturday November 13. 1841

A light breeze from the S to S W steering W E by N saw
2 or 3 to the windward steering to the N. W. saw two Islands
in site but no the names of them Lat 2.15 S Long 127.31 E

Sunday November 14. 1841

A light breeze from the S W steering N E saw black
ish at 4 P M. In site of several Islands. Very many Terns
Lockingong. Bullogaspe. Kekik. Lann. Pullan rock. Bulpis
song rocks. In view of islands Lat 1.11 S Long 128.22 E do ends

Monday November 15. 1841

A light breeze from the S S W steering N E
in ~~the~~ site of several Islands Lat 1.5 S Long 128.44 E

Tuesday November 16. 1841

Three 24 hours light breeze from the S S E to S S W steering
N E in site of the 2 islands of C. G. in the Pacific
Ocean Lat 4.1 N Long 129.20 E do ends

Bound towards the Whaling ground in the Pacific Ocean

Wednesday November 11. 1841

Three 24 hours variable winds steering by the line Course N E
Nothing in site all hands employed in ship's duty Lat 61 Long 125

Thursday November 12. 1841

Three 24 hours variable winds steering by the wind course E N E
and rain squalls nothing in site. Do Ends their 24 hours

Friday November 13. 1841

Three 24 hours light breeze from N to N W steering E half N
hands busy employed in ship's duty saw Grandheros and
Bopows Lat 1.52 N Long 130.20 E do ends their 24 hours

Saturday November 14. 1841

Three 24 hours light breeze and calm steering E Nothing in
site all hands busy employed in ship's duty Lat 1.52 N Long 131

Sunday November 15. 1841

Three 24 hours light breeze and squally from N to N
N E steering E Caught 24 Raupes at 8 P M
Nothing in sight Lat 2.02 N Long 131.25 E

Monday November 16. 1841

Three 24 hours light breezes and squally from N W to
N E steering E Nothing in sight Lat 1.48 N Long 131.10

Tuesday November 17. 1841

Three 24 hours strong breezes and heavy squalls from N to N E
steering E N E nothing in sight Lat 1.56 N Long 132.40 E

Wednesday November 18. 1841

Three 24 hours light breezes and calm E N E course Nothing
in sight Lat 2.02 N Long 133.24 E do ends their 24 hours
