Thursday November 23. 1841

These 24 hours light breezes from E steering on the wind nothing in sight Lat 1.43 N Long 133.44 E

Friday November 24. 1841

These 24 hours light breezes from NW to W steering on the wind nothing in sight Lat 1.30 N Long 133.55 E so ends these 24 hours

Saturday November 25. 1841

These 24 hours fresh breezes from NW to W steering on the wind nothing in sight Lat 2.03 N Long 133.30 E so ends these 24 hours

Sunday November 26. 1841

These 24 hours fresh breeze from W steering on the wind nothing in sight Lat 2.03 N Long 133.01 E so ends

Monday November 27. 1841

These 24 hours fresh breezes and squalls from W steering on the wind nothing in sight Lat 2.03 N Long 131.18 E

Tuesday November 28. 1841

These 24 hours fresh breezes and squalls of rain from W steering on the wind nothing in sight Lat 2.00 N Long 143.20 E

Wednesday December 1. 1841

These 24 hours fresh breezes and squalls of rain from W steering on the wind nothing in sight Lat 1.33 N Long 143.02 E

Thursday December 2. 1841

These 24 hours fresh breezes and heavy squalls of rain from W steering on the wind a pinback broke out for a new main sail and went under the old Lat 1.17 N Long 147.45 E

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Friday December 3. 1841

These 24 hours strong breezes from W to N steering on the wind nothing in sight Lat 1.44 N Long 151.40 E

Saturday December 4. 1841

These 24 hours variable winds and squalls weather from S to N steering on the wind nothing in sight Lat 1.44 N Long 151.40 E

Sunday December 5. 1841

These 24 hours light breezes from the S steering on the wind nothing in sight Lat 2.00 N Long 151.55 E

Monday December 6. 1841

These 24 hours light breezes from N to E steering on the wind nothing in sight Lat 2.25 N Long 152.25 E

Tuesday December 7. 1841

These 24 hours variable winds from S to N steering on the wind nothing in sight Lat 2.24 N Long 152.26 E

Wednesday December 8. 1841

These 24 hours calm and squalls of rain from the E to S steering on the wind Lat 2.20 N Long 152.28 E

Thursday December 9. 1841

These 24 hours strong breezes from E by S steering on the wind Raise humpbacks about 4. R. M. A. L. L. hand caught eyes in ship's duty Lat 1.22 N Long 152.17 E so ends

Friday December 10. 1841

These 24 hours light breezes from E steering on the wind Raise humpbacks Lat 0.00 N Long 152.02 E so ends
