Sunday March 13 1842

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from N. by E steering by the wind nothing in sight Lat 17 44 S Long 163 40 E so ends

Monday March 14 1842

This 24 hours light breeze from E. N. E. steering to the S. E. At 6 P.M. raised whales heard four boats full of after them the starboard boat went on and fastened and the iron hook came on board Lat 1.00 S Long 163 22 E

Tuesday March 15 1842

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E. N. E. steering by the wind to the S. E. At 3 P.M. raised whale heard 4 boats full of after them the starboard boat got 1 starboard 1 starboard 1 stock them along side about 9 o'clock P.M.  Lat 10 50 S Long 163 15 E

Wednesday March 16 1842

This 24 hours light breeze from E. N. E. steering S. E. nothing in sight continued heaving about 12 o'clock finished cutting in about 1 P.M. Lat by 11.10 S Long 164 10 E

Thursday March 17 1842

This 24 hours light breeze from E. N. E. steering S. E. nothing in sight finished heaving about 10 P.M. Lat 2.14 S Long 164 25 E

Friday March 18 1842

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from N. by W steering E. by S nothing in sight Lat 2 30 S Long 164 44 E

Saturday March 19 1842

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from N. E. steering E. S. E. nothing in sight Lat 03 50 S Long 165 20 E

This 24 hours light breeze from N. E. to E. N. E. steering on the wind to the S. E. nothing in sight Lat 5 15 S Long 166 00 E

Monday March 21 1842

This 24 hours variable winds steering by the wind N. E. to S. E. nothing in sight All hands busily employed in stowing down oil 40,000 we stowed down

Tuesday March 22 1842

This 24 hours light breeze from E. to S. E. steering by the wind to the S. and E. nothing in sight Lat 5 15 S Long 166 00 E

Wednesday March 23 1842

This 24 hours variable winds and squalls of rain steering by the wind to E. and S. Lat 6 00 S Long 167 00 E

Thursday March 24 1842

This 24 hours fresh breeze and squalls of rain from N. to E steering by the wind to S. and E. Lat 06 20 S Long 167 40 E

Friday March 25 1842

This 24 hours variable winds and squalls of rain steering by the wind nothing in sight Lat 7 30 S Long 168 20 E so ends

Saturday March 26 1842

This 24 hours light breeze and calm with variable winds steering by the wind nothing in sight Lat 8 44 S Long 168 34 E

Sunday March 27 1842

This 24 hours light breeze and calm with variable winds from N. to N. E. nothing in sight steering E. and E. by N. Lat by 8 26 S Long 169 01 E so ends
