Tuesday April 26

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E steering by the wind to the N and E nothing in sight Painted the larboard side of the ship outside Hulls 3 Tops Lat by Ch 2.22° S Long 178.50° E

Wednesday April 27

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E steering by the wind to the N and E nothing in sight Painted the larboard side of the ship outside Hulls 3 Tops Lat by Ch 2.35° S Long 178.26° E

Thursday April 28

This 24 hours variable winds and showers of rain steering by the wind to the N nothing in sight Lat 2.13° S Long 178.07° E

Friday April 29

This 24 hours variable winds and showers of rain steering by the wind to the N nothing in sight Lat by Ch 6.51° S Long by Ch and chronometer 178.35° E

Saturday April 30

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from N E to E steering by the wind to the N Painted Starboard and Masthead nothing in sight Calles 3 Tiggs Lat 6.20° S Long 178.20° E

Sunday May 1

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E steering by the wind to the N nothing in sight Painted Starboard and Masthead nothing in sight Lat by Ch 6.57° S Long 178.10° E and

Monday May 2

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from N E to E steering by the wind to the N nothing in sight Gent. Main top sail and mended it Lat 3.32° S Long 177.30° E

Tuesday May 3

This 24 hours fresh breeze from E steering by the wind to the N raised land at 6th No. Hope Island there was about 20 schooners come along to trade they brought Whales Shells Coconuts and hats Lat 2.42° S Long 177.55° E

Wednesday May 4

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from N E by E steering by the wind nothing in sight Lat 4.51° S Long 176.36° E

Thursday May 5

This 24 hours fresh breeze from N E by E steering by the wind raised Byrnes Island at 7th No about 30 boats came to trade brought 46 Coconuts and Whales We took one boat in for a good voyage from land supposed they had lost site of land there was about 30 in the boat men and Women and Children Lat 4.29° S Long 176.30° E

Friday May 6

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E steering by the wind Lat 5° P.M. raised wholea bore 3 boats put off after them did not see them Lat 20° S Long 176.07° E

Saturday May 7

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E steering by the wind nothing in sight Lat 3.5° S Long 175.20° E
