Sunday June 3

This 24 hours strong breeze and heavy squalls of rain from E by S steering by the wind to the N nothing in sight

Monday June 6

This 24 hours strong breeze and heavy squalls of rain from E by S steering by the wind to the N by E light at 3 PM raised Ocean Island bearing N Lat 01. 28 S

Tuesday June 7

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E by S cruising in sight of Ocean Island nothing in sight Lat 36 S

Wednesday June 8

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from N by E to E steering by the wind nothing in sight Lat

Thursday June 9

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from N by W steering by the wind to E at 3 PM hoisted away the boat and set a man a shore one that came a board to ship but did not like he had been a board 4 days on trial

Friday June 10

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E steering W by N all hands busy employed in braking out Beef Tack and coopersing it At 1 O'clock PM raised Whales board 4 boats and went off after them and chased them till half past 3 Lat

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Saturday June 11

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E steering by the wind to the N nothing in sight all hands busy employed in ships duty braking out and coopersing Beef Tack Lat 33 S 168 28 E

Sunday June 12

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E cruising between Present and Ocean Island nothing in sight Lat 28 S Long 168 10 E


Monday June 13

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E cruising between Present and Ocean Island nothing in sight Lat 28 S

Tuesday June 14

This 24 hours light breeze from E cruising nothing in sight

Wednesday June 15

This 24 hours calm Present Island in sight bearing S W At 7 AM raised Whales hoisted 4 boats part of after them the West Boat went off on and fastened and got 3 the others not any  look along side 13 1/2

Thursday June 16

This 24 hours light breeze Present Island bearing S W nothing in sight a number of Coconos came off to trade bread & Chickens and Coconuts All hands busy employed in cutting in commenced cutting at sunrise and finished at 10 PM
