

60 Journal kept on board of Sharon
Bound in to Ventnor to recruit

Tuesday October 11

This 24 hours variable winds and squalls of rain came from the N. W. at 10 o'clock a small island in sight 5th half past 11 raised anchor
boarded three boats and chased till 6 o'clock came a board and
took up the boats Lat by 11.57 Long 16.15.6

Wednesday October 12

This 24 hours strong breeze from S. E. to S. with squalls
of rain starting at 10 o'clock at 11 o'clock the
raised Wellington's Island at 12 o'clock several vessels
came off and brought coconuts, pineapples and taro
Lat by 16.25 N Long 16.20.6

Thursday October 13

This 24 hours light breeze from S. E. with squalls of
rain starting at 11 o'clock at 12 o'clock the
Ventnor Lat by 16.35 N Long 15.15.6

Friday October 14

This 24 hours light breeze from S. to N. with squalls
of rain at 11 o'clock took a pilot but did not get in to
anchor Ship Edward Corp of San Francisco 13 months
out 30th of 8 lying at anchor the second boat
blew off his hand by losing a gun.

Saturday October 15

This 24 hours light breeze from S. E. and S. at 10 o'clock
came to anchor to Ventnor about half a mile from the
shore brought 1 bag some fish and plenty of girls for
tobacco and shells for blacker.

Sunday October 16

This 24 hours light breeze from S. E. to S. E. with
squalls at anchor in morning brought some shells and
Yams and coconuts Lat by 16.40 N Long 15.11.6

Monday October 17

This 24 hours light breeze with squalls of rain
took a raft of coals a shore and fired them and took
them aboard the ship and started them in to the
hole got off two boatloads of wood brought 3 bags
in a lot of Yams some shells some chickens

Tuesday October 18

This 24 hours variable winds with squalls of rain got
100 lb of water and two boatloads of wood some Yams

Wednesday October 19

This 24 hours light breeze from S. E. to S. still lying
at anchor in morning got off a raft of water
and two boatloads of wood and 4 lb of sugar
in the night and had a mus with the four men
at hands and put two men in 200 one for repairing
to catch the officer for taking up for him

Thursday October 20

This 24 hours heavy variable winds got two boatloads
of wood and sunk one the caught these men that were
away the day before

Friday October 21

This 24 hours variable winds and calms got off raft of water
and 3 boatloads of wood
