Saturday October 22

This 24 hours fresh breeze from S.E. and S.W. still
lying at anchor the two boats hooked off duty because the
captain said that he would not give them any liberty
afterwards he told them that he would give them
three days each watch if they would go to work which
they did agree to

Sunday October 23

This 24 hours variable winds the two men went a shore in
liberty and eight of them run away

Monday October 24

This 24 hours fresh breeze from the other side went a shore
in liberty and they run along painted the head of the foremast
side and varnished the mast

Tuesday October 25

This 24 hours variable winds and squalls of rain four men
went a shore in liberty and one runaway got one boatload
of wood

Wednesday October 26

This 24 hours variable winds and squalls of rain still
lying at anchor in position

Thursday October 27

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from N.E. steering
S.E. with squalls of rain at 6 P.M. hoisted up
the foremast and took the anchor but the wind being
light the current set her astern and we got out a large
anchor and hove her off and made all sail and got
out the harbour we had a flagstaff taken from
the maintopgallant mast head and several pieces
of rigging and some more run away

This 24 hours fresh breeze from N.E. steering S.E.
with squalls of rain Lat by alt 16. 55 N Long 161. 12 E

Thursday November 3

This 24 hours fresh breeze from N.E. by E to S.E. steering
S.E. nothing in sight all hands busy caulking in
stowing away sheets Lat by alt 16. 45 N Long 162. 24 E

Friday November 4

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from N.E. to S.E. steering
S.E. nothing in sight Lat by alt 16. 28 N
Long 162. 20 E as ends the 24 hours
