Saturday February 25

wind to the S. with squalls of rain. At 6 P.M.
took in the foretop under the four top sails, masts and
closed reefed main top sail and fore topsail.

Sunday February 26

This 24 hours strong breeze with squalls of rain from
N by N.W. under closed reefed main top sail and fore topsail
and foretop sail stole.

Monday February 27

This 24 hours fresh breeze from N with squalls of rain
steering to the N. at 6 P.M. under closed reefed top sails
and fore sail at 4 P.M. got out the foretop at 6 P.M. took
in sail heading to S. Lat by 32.30 S Long 17.30 W

Tuesday February 28

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from N by N steering
to S and N. nothing in sight all hands busy im-
ployed in stowing down oil. Lat by 32.30 S

Wednesday February March 1

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from N steering nothing in
sight all hands busy in stowing down oil. Lat by 32.30 S Long 17.30 W

Thursday March 2

This 24 hours pleasant breeze with squalls of rain steering
to S and N. nothing in sight. Lat by 32.30 S Long 17.30 W

This 24 hours light breeze from N to S steering by the
wind and N. nothing in sight. Carried the mast out as
