This 24 hours pleasant weather bought some yams 12 hogs some ~~hams~~ bananas & some

Monday May 29

This 24 hours lying to anchor bought some hogs some yams

Tuesday May 30

This 24 hours lying to anchor in Sooths bought 11 hogs some ~~yams~~ and got off some casks of water

Wednesday May 31

This 24 hours lying to anchor in Sooths bought some hogs some yams

Thursday June 1

This 24 hours pleasant weather bought some hogs some yams

Friday June 2

This 24 hours pleasant weather from Land & bought some hogs and yams 3 men left the ship in the and we shipped 8 more

Saturday June 3

This 24 hours light breeze from Land at 6 A.M. took anchor at 9 A.M. the Pilot left us stood along the land at 3 P.M. raised Whales Coard 2 boats put off after them did not get fast aboard at dark one of the foremost hands went to the captain to get his needles the captain would not give it to him he said then the Pilot had since his death went to had a light boat at the time the compass took him and put him in some and took him to the

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Sunday June 4

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from S with squalls of rain Standing off and on to Sooths

Monday June 5

This 24 hours fresh breeze from S stood in to the Island of Sooths and sent a boat ashore and shipped 8 men that left the Em by Morgan of New Bedford

Tuesday June 6

This 24 hours fresh breeze from S to S by S stood in to the land and sent a boat ashore and fetched off a man that left the ship before we took anchor at 9 P.M. raised Whales did not lose for them they was going to the windard

Wednesday June 7

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from S. Cruising Sooths in sight and Tortawilla at 6 P.M.

Thursday June 8

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from S. Cruising Sooths in sight at Sooths and Tortawilla at 6 P.M.

Friday June 9

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from S. Cruising Sooths and Tortawilla in sight

Saturday June 10

This 24 hours light breeze from S. Cruising Sooths in sight and Tortawilla

Sunday June 11

This 24 hours light breeze from N. Cruising to W of Sooths about 5 to 12 miles from land nothing in sight

Monday June 12

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from S. Cruising to the N. Nothing in sight at 10 P.M. Long 174.32 W

This 24 hours fresh breeze from S. Cruising by the wind to Sooths Lat by 174.41 Long 174.34 W
