Cruising about the Teague Islands

Wednesday August 19

This 24 hours fresh breeze from E to S under double
reefed topsails Coakenut Island in sight two barks

Thursday August 20

This 24 hours first part heavy winds from SE steering
E. S. E. at 8 AM took in all sail but closed reefed main
top-sail and hauled out four and main spencers at the
same time stove the bow-boat took her in and commenced
mending her finished mending main top gallant sail and
lashed it

Friday August 21

This 24 hours light breeze E to SE in sight of Coakenut
Island two barks in sight

Saturday August 22

This 24 hours light breeze E in sight of land

Sunday August 23

This 24 hours pleasant breeze E in sight of
Coakenut Island

Monday August 24

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E in sight of land one canoe
came off with yams Coakenut Is. and Mumcapples

Tuesday August 25

This 24 hours light breeze from E at 8 AM went a
shore with a boat and got Ban nanahs Coakenut yams
and Mumcapples

Wednesday August 26

This 24 hours fresh breeze E to SE cruising near Coa-
kenut Island

Thursday August 27

This 24 hours light breeze from E cruising near the land

Friday August 28

This 24 hours variables and squalls at 8 AM raised Whales bores
at 10 AM that fastened on him took him along side at
12 AM commenced cutting at 4 finished at 6 started the work
at 12 at minute

Saturday August 29

This 24 hours fresh breeze from E at 11 AM saw Healy
a whaling boat of the Struck and killed only one whale
in sight we finished boiling at 6 PM

of Coakenut Island London Packet in sight

Tuesday August 21

This 24 hours light breeze from E cruising two barks in
sight

Wednesday August 22

London Packet Bound to Batamah after wood and water
150 to fill her

Thursday August 23

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E cruising near the
land spoke the bark

Friday August 24

This 24 hours light breeze from E cruising in sight
of Coakenut Island

Saturday August 25

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E cruising near the
land two canoes come off to the ship with coakenut and mumc
apples

Sunday August 26

This 24 hours strong breeze
took four and mizzen top

Monday August 27

This 24 hours strong breeze
double reefed top-sail at 6 AM in four and mizzen
top-sails

Tuesday August 28

This 24 hours first part strong breeze and squalls of
rain from N E to E later part light at 8 AM
raised whales going to the wind at 10 PM hoisted
3 part was that part and mizzen to fur off under way

Wednesday August 29

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E at 11 AM went a shore
of Coakenut Island got yams and banana and mumcapples

Thursday August 30

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E cruising in sight of land
bark Healy in sight two setting up shooks and mended
the shank
