under all sail Sunday Island in sight and Goddard in sight

Monday October 30
This 24 hours first part light later part calm steering by the wind
to the S Lat by Ob 28.25 S Long 176.53 W

Tuesday October 31
This 24 hours light breeze from W steering by the wind
to the S under all sail Lat by Ob 28.44 S Long 176.07 W

Wednesday November 1
This 24 hours fresh breeze from S.W. steering by the wind to
W of W Lat by Ob

Thursday November 2
This 24 hours strong breeze from S steering by the wind to
the S and W Lat by Ob 28.11 S Long 175.06

Friday November 3

double reefed topsails at 3 P.M. took in fore and main

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from S steering under all sail
at 6 P.M. struck 3 B'ys and one of them Lat by Ob 32.50 S Long 172.16 E

Thursday November 9
This 24 hours light breeze from S to S.E. coast S by W hauled
for Water and about Lat by Ob 34.32 S Long 176.32 E

Friday November 10
This 24 hours pleasant breeze from S to S.E. steering to the S.E. at
6 P.M. raised the mast at 12 lower 4 boats that had fastened and killed
Larboard boat fastened and took his line Starboard boat fastened

This 24 hours strong breeze from S steering S.E. under double reefed
main topsail and single sail all day in boiling Lat by Ob 34.09 S
Long 174.22 E

Tuesday November 14
This 24 hours pleasant breeze from S steering S.E. under all sail
finished boiling at 4 P.M. Lat by Ob 34.09 S Long 173.36 E

Wednesday November 15
This 24 hours fresh breeze from W to W steering S.W. at 6 P.M. took
ship heading to the W all hands busy in stowing down sail
stowed down 30 lbs Lat by Ob 33.05 S Long 171.30 E

Thursday November 16
This 24 hours pleasant breeze from W to W steering by the
wind to S under double reefed topsails and main sail finished
stowing down at 11 P.M. Lat by Ob 33.12 S Long 171.52 E
