part more light Lat 25.23 S Long 154.13 W

Sunday October 20  
This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E by S to S by E steering by the wind  
to S and E Lat by 25.15 S Long 153.53 W

Monday October 21  
This 24 hours light breeze from E by S to S steering S by E and by the  
wind Lat by 25.08 S Long 152.48 W

Tuesday October 22  
This 24 hours light breeze from E by S to S steering S by E and by  
the wind Lat by 24.50 S Long 152.22 W

Wednesday October 23  
This 24 hours first part fresh breeze from S by E steering by the wind later  
part strong breeze to with rain Lat by 24.41 S Long 151.41 W

Thursday October 24

This 24 hours fresh breeze from S steering by the wind to  
the southward and eastward Lat by 24.22 S Long 150.24 W

This 24 hours first part light gale and squally later part more  
light from S steering to the eastward at 8 A.M. tacked  
ship heading to southward and westward under double reefed tops  
ails Lat by 24.32 S Long 149.32 W

This 24 hours calms with light air and variable breeze  
in fitting rigging Lat by 24.55 S Long 150.05 W

Wednesday October 30  
This 24 hours light breeze from the W steering S by E under  
all sail lower and top and topallant studsails Lat by 24.39 S  
Long 149.09 W

Thursday October 31  
This 24 hours pleasant breeze from W steering S by E under all  
sail with studsails out Lat by 24.31 S Long 148.31 W

Friday November 1  
This 24 hours fresh breeze from W with rain and foggy  
steering S by E Lat by 24.10 S Long 147.30 W

Saturday November 2  
This 24 hours pleasant breeze from W to W steering S by E  
Lat by 24.42 S Long 148.10 W

Sunday November 3  
This 24 hours light breeze from W steering S by E saw  
Blackfish Lat by 24.57 S Long 147.57 W

Monday November 4  
This 24 hours fresh breeze from W steering S by E thick and foggy  
at 7 struck a light on a shoal Lat by 24.28 S Long 148.00 W

Tuesday November 5  
This 24 hours fresh breeze from W steering S by E at 12 A.M. light off

This 24 hours strong breeze from W steering S half S Lat by 24.55

This 24 hours a gale from weather and water with squalls of rain  
steering S under stowed main topmast and foremast at 5 PM  
the foretopmast and reefed the foremast Lat by 24.07 S Long
