40 miles from us a steamer and saw two steering to the S and W
supposed them to be merchantmen Lat 46.13 N Long 52.25

Monday January 13

This 24 hours light breeze from E steering N W all hands busy in
painting outside of the ship Lat 48.19 N Long 54.25

Tuesday January 14

This 24 hours light breeze from E steering N W all hands busy
in painting ship Lat 49.33 N Long 56.31 W

Wednesday January 15

This 24 hours pleasant breeze from E steering N W half N
Lat 51.07 N Long 57.38 W

Thursday January 16

This 24 hours strong breeze from E steering N W with squalls
of rain Lat 53.03 N Long 59.50 W

Friday January 17

This 24 hours light breeze from E steering N W half N At 8 A.M. spoke

under close reefed maintop sail and reefed fore sail steering by the

double reefed maintop sail and reefed fore sail Lat 34.07 N Long 74.25

Tuesday January 28

sight one bark one brig standing on the wind to the S and E and N and W
