The day, except through the day in making
at 10 AM commenced to
large double reef topsail take in mainmast
and jib.

with a stiff breeze at 5 AM. took in
reef topsail, and we kept the main
beam sail of wood through the day wind
about N.W. being to under the reef main
topsail. at 11 PM. set the foresail and

of water got an abrasion through the day.

Friday 5th these 24 hours commenced with
a heavy breeze of wind. at 6 AM. took in fore
sail, and kept her to the wind. at 11 AM. got

of set the foresail and double reef fore and
topsail shrouing S.E. later in the day
and a heavy rain falling. Lat ~~32~~ ³¹ Long ~~118~~ ¹¹⁷

Sat 6th these twenty four hours commenced with a steady
breeze double reef fore and main topsail shrouing
S.E. employed the fore part of the day in
baking out fresh water some meat and a barrel
of blue fish. middle and latter part shifted to
the port and did most of duty in account
of sick men. the Capt. having the barbed
watch at night. mainmast and jib set
in double reef main topsail. Lat ~~31~~ ³⁰ Long ~~118~~ ¹¹⁷

Sun 7th these 24 hours commenced with
stiff breeze, under double reef topsail and
single reef main sail. at 6 AM. much sail set main topsail

middle part moderate breeze at 9 AM. commenced
to breeze at 10 PM. commenced to
take in sail double reef topsail. Lat ~~29~~ ²⁸ Long ~~118~~ ¹¹⁷

Monday 8th these twenty four hours commenced
with a stiff breeze. the mate having to move
water. at 10 AM. commenced to make sail
the main topsail and sent it down
observation observation through the day. latter
part to us were the wind varying several
points nothing worthy of notice through
the remainder of these 24 hours.

Tues 9th these twenty four hours commenced
with a stiff breeze about 5 PM. the
fore part shrouing E. at 6 PM. raised the main
sail and main topsail. 1 mile part
stiff breeze shrouing S.E. latter part more
moderate. Lat ~~28~~ ²⁷ Long ~~118~~ ¹¹⁷

Wed 10th these twenty four hours commenced with
moderate breeze at 5 AM. commenced to breeze
take in topsail at 10 AM. took in the
fore topsail at 11 PM. put in the mainmast
and double reef the mainmast
heavy shower of rain and there a calm in the
remainder of these twenty four hours at 9 AM. 6 PM.
crossed the mainmast and stacked the rig out
of the fore and main topsail. the latter part
nearly calm. Lat ~~27~~ ²⁶ Long ~~118~~ ¹¹⁷

Thu 11th these twenty four hours commenced with
a light breeze at 10 AM. sent down the main
topsail as the fore main sail and covered
main shrouing gear and a double purchase
got two boats of the house and waremasted
through the remainder of the day in going
