

South Atlantic January 24th

the clouting sail, and hoisted the jacks
around on the larboard tack heading to the
southeast and westward. our sail in sight
at 4th past 5 P.M. heard three boats to
practise row and three in hours with
a light breeze. Lat 29.58 S Long 44.54 W

These twenty four hours commenced with
with a moderate breeze. employed the fore part
of the day in hauling out fresh water. at 8 P.M.
hoisted a sail of the starboard bow on the starboard
tack she soon tacked ship and stood for us
at 5 P.M. pick her. she proved to be the Champion
of West India. Capt. Cartwright. months out 900 sps
homeward bound. governed with her for about
two hours. got about five gallons of oil for her
her. sent some letters home by her. middle
and latter part much the same. Lat 29.58 S Long 44.54 W

These twenty four hours commenced
with a moderate breeze. the fore part and in
the job and mended it and then bent it
again. the latter part had a main spence
middle and latter part strong breeze. shading
S.W. at sail and wind about two points off
the starboard tack. Lat 29.58 S Long 44.54 W

These twenty four hours commenced with dark
cloudy weather and flashes of lightning
at 1 A.M. took in main reef and studding
about 6 o'clock up fore and main by jacks
at 5 P.M. set the light sails again. our sail
in sight. middle and latter part much
the same. Lat 29.58 S Long 44.54 W

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with a moderate breeze. at 2 A.M. commenced
breeze. took in by jacks. and single
up fore and main topsail. at 10 A.M. while
at mast head I was at sea sick and
reminded it being the first time since
leaving home. middle and latter part
much the same. Lat 29.58 S Long 44.54 W

These twenty four hours commenced
with a strong breeze. at 10 A.M. hoisted the
main and top sails. we are now on the
River ground. steering on the wind
latter part nearly calm. with a heavy
well on. Lat 30.24 S Long 45.24 W

These twenty four hours commenced with
a light breeze. hoisted the jacks around
on the starboard tack. middle and latter
and latter part much the same.

Lat 29.58 S Long 44.54 W

These twenty four hours commenced
with a strong breeze at 6 A.M. took in
top sails. at 1 P.M. took up fore
main sail and jib. took in
the bow and waist took out with and
at light gale latter part more moderate
Lat 29.04 S Long 44.20 W. Lat 29.58 S Long 44.54 W

These twenty four hours commenced
with a stiff breeze under double wind courses
at 11 o'clock up fore topsail. took in the
main sail at jib at 4th past 5 A.M. at 5 P.M. took
up fore and main topsail. at 8 P.M. took
up fore and main topsail and also kept
the main. the wind being in heavy
gale. nothing worth of notice. Lat 29.58 S Long 44.54 W
