

20 South Atlantic February 4th 1857

with moderate breeze at 4 PM. made
all sail and ship in sight of the starboard
quarter. employed through the day in
making out fresh water rigging and
muzzles. latter part strong breeze started
latter about wind for the starboard quarter

Feb 5th these four hours commenced with
a strong breeze with thick haze weather
employed the fore part of day in putting
on shapings gear at 1 PM. took in topgallant
sails at 1 PM. single reef topsails at 1 PM. the
middle and latter part the main
muzzles the 2 hours. Lat 11 50 S Long 54 50 W

Feb 6th these four hours commenced with
a strong breeze. the fore part under double
reef topsails and jib. and away the
muzzling back reef. put on a table
in a substitute for a back reef. at 1 PM. set
topsails and topgallant sails. employed the
latter part in putting on shapings gear
on the main and muzzles topsails
rigging. middle and latter part light
breeze. air goes begins to grow quiet and
survive at 5 AM. wind set at 4 PM. PM. 6
Lat 11 50 S Long 54 50 W

Feb 7th these four hours commenced with a light
breeze. at 2 PM. commenced to breeze squared
in the main yards and set the ludding
staring to the southward and westward
commenced the this afternoon to day to
see us to work and working. averaging 4 knots
middle and latter part strong breeze all sail set.

Feb 8th these four hours commenced

At Sea South Atlantic February 10th 1857

with fresh breeze from the southward and eastward all
sail set at 4 PM. took in the light
muzzles and double reefed the topsails. sailed at
the weather fair. at 1 PM. commenced to make
sail. at 1 PM. took in the main muzzles. S.W.
middle and latter part light breeze seven or eight
hours. Lat 11 50 S Long 54 50 W

Feb 9th these four hours commenced with
a moderate breeze all sail set staring to
the southward and westward. the middle and
latter part fresh breeze at
1 PM. double reefed topsails and topsails. at 1 PM.
topgallant sails and topsails. at 1 PM. took in

at 7 PM. hauled up the fore sail and hauled
back the head yards and secured sail out
6 sets fire. pathosic but good.
