this day commenced with a strong breeze from the North. at 4 PM. pulled the main topsail, and let go the lashed on her. at 5 PM. the doctor came on board to see the cooper. at 8 PM. took up the lashed and her around this day.

Tuesday this day commenced with a breeze like day. employed through the day in working on the boats. four ships left this port to day. and the Chilean man-of-war. she came here to land troops. to go back in the country to relieve the troops in the country.

Wednesday this day commenced with a strong breeze. the ship has been ready for sea now nearly a week. the boats are all painted and ready for sailing. at 8 PM. nothing worth of notice at 11 PM. the protest made out and signed.
