breeze middle double reefed topsails and mizen. topsail
single reefed mizen topsail at 8 PM. set head

June 28th these 24 hours commenced with a
moderate breeze all sail set. staying to the westward
at 5 PM. shifted over the studdingsails on the larboard
tack. employed through the day in baking out
the mizen hatch. middle part mended the

and doubled reefed topsails. staying N.W. wind
