

68 North Pacific Ocean Oct 11. 1857.

Mon 10th these 24 hours commenced with a moderate breeze, all sail set steering E by S. employed the fore part of the day in taking out corn and dried apples and scraping bone, middle and latter part much the same. Lat 49-00 N Long 144-10 West

Tues 11th this day commenced with a moderate breeze, all sail set steering E by S. wind from the north and westward employed the most of the day in mending the fore top, masts, studding sails and making a single topmast stay sail. commenced to be studding mastsheads at 10. middle and latter part much the same. Lat 46-24 N Long 146-11 West

Wed 12th this day commenced with a moderate breeze, all sail set steering E by S. employed through the day in washing and drying beans. sheathing cover a studding sail. middle and latter part much the same. Lat 44-00 N Long 148-00 West

Thurs 13th these 24 hours commenced with a moderate breeze, all sail set steering E by S. employed the middle part in mending studding sails. at 11th mended a sail of the tacked bow, wind about N by W. at 3 P.M. mended the masts heads, studding sails. latter part steering E by S. compass. latter part frequent signals from the vessel and water.

Fri 14th these 24 hours commenced with frequent squalls from the north and westward, the fore part sheathing studding sails, steering the fore part E by S. latter part E by S. by compass. mainmast and foremast studding sail set. the latter part breeze and clear.

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Sat 15th this day commenced with a light breeze steering to the southward and eastward, braced nearly sharp the fore part wind about N by E. two sails in sight at 10th sighted one of them. at 11th put the waist and bow beam over in the cranes. the latter part braced sharp up heading about S. E. second. Lat 36-00 North

Sund 16th this day commenced with a light breeze at 8 A.M. took in studding sails. three sails in sight this morning from the mast head. middle and latter part much the same. Lat 34-24 N

Mon 17th these 24 hours commenced with a light breeze, all sail set steering on the wind, employed through the day in washing and drying beans. latter part the wind to the southward of east. middle and latter part much the same. Lat 32-38 North
Long 157-34 West

Tues 18th these twenty four hours commenced with a light breeze. at 6 A.M. tacked ship and headed to the eastward. heading about E by N. through the day employed through the day in bunching beans. middle and latter part much the same. Lat 31-2 N
Long 157-44 West

Wed 19th these twenty four hours commenced with a light breeze. at 10 A.M. tacked ship and headed on the starboard tack. heading about E by N. the compass employed through the day in washing the inside of the ship. latter part together of heavy squalls. Lat 29-54 N

Thurs 20th this day commenced with a light breeze, all sail set steering on the wind, employed through the day in washing the
