

96 South Pacific Feb 1st 1854

Mon 1st these 24 hours commenced with a moderate breeze, employed through the day working in the rigging and making main brace pennants. at 1 PM raised white water and small sprouts, called them sperm whales. found the three larked boats, chased about 2 and 1/2 hours, and then came alongside again, but when saw them - made at 4 PM took in the light sails and close down the topsails, hauled up the courses, and stood quarter watches through the night, rather squally through the night.

Tues 2nd these 24 hours commenced with a squally weather, standing quarter watch at daylight called the west of the last watch and made sail, employed through the day in working in the rigging, and mending the cold main again. sail, at sun down shortened sail, middle and latter part much the same, standing on the wind, working to the north and eastward.

Wed 3rd these 24 hours commenced with a moderate breeze, at daylight made sail, employed through the day in mending the cold M. J. G. sail, and working in the rigging, from 4 to 1 PM heavy squalls of wind and rain at 6 PM double reefed topsails, at night stood quarter water watches, steering on the wind from the eastward, on the back that we can make the night neither wind nor eastward.
