

900 North Pacific Feb 20th 1856

Sat 20th these 24 hours commenced with a light breeze, steering N.W. by W. middle part very light. at 6 PM a strong breeze sprung up, took in S. M. S. studding sails and fore and main. at 9 PM wind hauled about E. latter part more moderate. Sat Feb 21st Long 154 27

Sun 21st these twenty four hours commenced with a moderate breeze, steering N.W. by W. all sail set. at 12 PM kept her of W. middle part much the same. at 6 PM made Oahu. latter part strong breeze might before the wind, strong breeze: all sail set. 19. 45 N Long 153 40 W

Mon 22nd these 24 hours commenced with a strong breeze, steering for Moorea. at daylight kept to the wind. at 4 PM raised anchor. on the 24 hours at 4 PM got the cables up. middle and latter part wind light. at 6 PM

Tues 23rd these 24 hours commenced with moderate breeze, under double reefed topsails. at 6 AM made all sail. at 9 AM strong breeze took in top and studding sails. at 4. double reefed topsails. at 10 made all hands and got the anchor up. and made all sail. at 12 PM took in the light sails. and double reefed. at 1 PM hoisted away three boats. and took the ship off shore. about 4 PM came along side and took up the boats. about 1 PM were shot and stood off on the account of there being so much wind at 5 raised a sail of the fore and main. latter part more moderate. at set the jib and main sail.

North Pacific Feb 24th 1855

Wed 24th these 24 hours commenced with moderate breeze, under double reef topsails. at 11 AM spoke the Ship Aro. took in the light sails and kept to the main yard aback. light breeze.

Th 25th these 24 hours commenced with a moderate breeze, lapping with the main yard. at 3 AM braced forward. at 4. strong breeze; double reefed topsails. at 11 AM took in topsails. at 2 PM took in M. topsails. lapping with a double reef M. topsails. employed fore part in breaking out molasses. latter part more moderate.

Fri 26th these 24 hours commenced with moderate breeze, lapping to under a double reef M. topsails. at 6 AM set double reefed topsails. at 9 AM made all sail steering to the wind. at 3 PM strong breeze took in the S. & G. sails. at 10 PM took in the S. & G. sails. the passage being about 100 and a half points on the bow. and made all sail. latter part wind light from the

Sat 27th these 24 hours commenced with moderate breeze, standing in shore. at 11 AM studding sails. at about 4 PM anchored in Laeina. sent about shore and got fresh meat and potatoes. employed the fore part of the 24 in breaking out fresh water
