

of cash. to day. latter part foggy. with a moderate breeze. at 6 AM the boat went across the bay.

Sat. 14th this day commenced with a summer like day. employed the fore part of this day in getting of water. and stowing it down. at 2 PM sight of a small boat. for winter. then being no salmon to take. our things and came ashore. in order to what on Fair Island. and one of the women King (on Fair Island. for rather. to what it well from there) we have about seven hundred

barrels of cash now on shore. all together. I imagine. and a little rain. have had two more with those of the Cicero too. we have eight men from the mountain all day. to lookout for each ship making 16 in all. including the boats. but saw nothing. with the exception of Carpenter of the Shaven. the officers. and some sea ship. boiling standing out for Bowhead island. made from both ship. and provisions for week and latter part nearly calm. at 5 PM. months.

Sun. 15th this day commenced with a strong breeze and steady rain. three boats from the Shaven arrived this morning started for Seavoy. the ship Cicero. this morning here up and went out. the latter part of this day we were employed in making a cock house.

Mon. 17th this day commenced with a summer like day. this morning I took a boat and went on board of the ship and got a few. the west of the men were employed in enlarging the tent. and placing our beds up from the ground (or in other words making beds) and thatching the cock house. the latter part much like the fore part at 5 PM the ship sent in a raft of pipes.

Tues. 20th this day commenced with a light breeze. about 1 PM past 4 PM. took the boat and went on a short cruise. at about 9 AM. within gunshot of a whipsack. fired shot at him. but missed him (I suppose him to have been about 1500 yds off) middle part very foggy. fog. latter part
