

back for the island. but saw no whales. one boat went up to Greenwell. saw
one. but as my tooth ache is bad that day I did not go in the boat in the afternoon. latter part very light.

Sept 4th this day commenced with a breeze and thick fog. middle and latter part more light. at night one more ship arrived here. two ships now laying at anchor off the N.W. part of the island.

Sept 5th this day commenced with a breeze and steady rain. at 5 PM. raised two whales. chased them a short time but with no success.

Monday and Tues 6th these two days are very pleasant they seem very much like spring. went up to Greenwell point with the boats saw whales both days: in the morning the wind had prevailed from the north and east and the latter part of the day the wind came from the southward and westward. this morning (in the) the Ship St. George and Sava Samsh. on the 6 we were visited by Capt. Sopomas. and also by a boat of Dobry. which came here after the flukes for food.

Thurs 7th this day commenced with a thick cloudy weather. went up to Greenwell point. it came in thick we came back again and brought a boat. had of wind back at night.

Sept 9th this day commenced with a light breeze. one boat went up to Greenwell. saw one whale during the day. and when coming home we saw a small Bear. which seemed very tame but at last he braved off.

Sept 10th this day commenced with a strong breeze. went up to Greenwell to day but saw nothing. wind to day is about N.W. the men ashore to day and yesterday have been employed in burning coal.

Sept 11th this day commenced with light breeze from the Southward and westward. saw three whales to day at 9 AM. Bark Midas raised two fine whales. the men mud and latter part light breeze.

Sept 12 this day commenced with a strong breeze. went on board of the Midas this morning and got about a tierce of bread. and carried board of her a barrel of Salmon. in evening. felt quite unwell to day at 1 PM. took a dose of calomel & Colic. have not been well much of the time since we got the whale. latter part fresh breeze.

Sept 13th this day commenced with a strong breeze. two sails raised here to day. the Bark. Smith left Nord. she came through the inside of the island. and the Ship Eliza came. middle part rainy. latter part moderate. felt quite unwell to day.
