

repacked main topsail and fore topsail staysails
at 6 AM. kept her up till 8 AM. set a whole
sail and double reefed fore and the foresail
took the same and found us 110 miles from
straits at 3 PM. took in the the main
boat and put them over the bows. at
10 PM. took in sail and left the ship to
the starboard tack again

Monday this day commenced with a fresh breeze
being too under a double reefed main
topsail at daylight made all sail and
steered to the southward and eastward. at 10 AM.
raised the southern island of the straits
at 4 PM. was up abreast of it at 7 PM. sent
the Mike yard. middle and latter part
saw no light. so ends Lat 53° 25' Long

Tuesday this day commenced with a light breeze
at daylight set studding sail and kept her
up till 8 PM. employed the fore part of the day in
hauling out fresh water. sent up the the larboard
M. J. G. boom cut some new rigging in
the sail. at 1 PM. sent down the larboard
J. boom and sent up another. at 1 PM. got
bill from Capt King but found that it
not agree with my book. middle part a whole
sail breeze. latter part fresh took in the J. sails.
and M. J. G. sail steering E by S at 4 PM. 12
down the larboard chain. at 5 PM. sent down
the cutting falls. at 4 PM. took in the light
sails Lat 50° 10' Long 158° 10' East

Wednesday this commenced with a strong breeze
at 2 AM. had all sail on her again. at 6 AM.
new new M. J. G. braces. put on a fresh
base on the M. J. sail yard. and now a steady ship
sailing very heavy. at 5

repacked main topsail braces. middle and latter
sails. took in the the main
Long 162° 05' E

at 9th this day commenced with a fresh breeze
being E by S. all set. wither breeze. at 11 AM.
up the starboard M. J. G. boom. and ran
up rigging for it. wind varying from
E by S. middle and latter part fresh breeze
Lat 51° 05' Long

on 10th this day commenced with a moderate
breeze from about N. W. steering E by N. by compass
employed the fore part of this day in sending
the fore and M. J. G. yards. middle and latter
part much like the first. Lat 48° 30' Long 170° 50' East

on 11th this day commenced with a light
breeze. varying from N. W. to S. W. steering
eastward all sail set. studding sail down
and stood mastheads all day to day but
nothing. middle and latter part a very
light air. so ends this day Lat 48° 30' Long

on 12th this day commenced with a moderate
breeze all sail set. at 1 PM. braced sharp up and
in the studding sail. at 3 PM. took in
the wind about S. E. ship heading
E by N. by compass at 1 PM. took in the J.
sails. at 4 PM. past 2 PM. double reefed the tails
and she was lying too under a close reef
topsail and M. J. G. sail. and J. M. J. sail
a strong gale of wind from S. E.

on 13th these 24 hours commenced with a strong
breeze from S. E. lying too heading E by N. at 3 PM.
commenced to haul to the southward. but
ship sailing very heavy. at 5
