Jan 25th employed the fore part in
up a little rigging, and carrying a
boatload of dust of and clearing up
about decks. the latter part employed
in washing of the port side of the
ship outside. this being the first time
day since we sailed from home

Jan 26. Jan 27 employed these two days in
washing the ship outside. three of us to work

Jan 28. this day commenced very beautiful
this day was spent on the princely part
of it on board the Dark Crested, helping
Capt. Mason make out a inventory of
ships stores in the evening attended

Jan 29 employed to day in washing the
side of the ship. the fore part R. B. and myself
the latter part had two Kanakas

Jan 30th employed the fore and middle part
of the day in washing ship the latter
part in hauling out between decks
Capt of the Main mast. two Carpenters
overboard. one of them have just fixed
the masts the is to work. taking the
earnings of the after hatch. sent two
letters to day by mail, at about 9 AM
J. Wright came on board and took
charge of the ship as third officer

Jan 31st employed to day in cleaning out the
cabin and cleaning the dishes. the latter part
this day very rainy. Jan 2nd employed to
day in working about decks. the weather is
clear but very chilly

Jan 3rd employed part of this day in baking
a few fish, and repacking them and stow
ing them away, the remainder of the day working
about decks. five Carpenters to work on the
cabin have tore the cabin all down and to
day they are commencing to put up the
bulkheads

Jan 4th employed to day in clearing up decks
and jacking about. the carpenters are to work in
the cabin and cutting a hatch through the

Jan 5th this day commenced with a beautiful
morning. attended Church three times to day
Jan 6th Rev. S. Cannon the Laman (chief)
