Sateahum Monday March 19th 1851

the funeral of the Bark Reager Capt Stewart
the day from Matten 24th of the month
we shall be taken and the other Capt. it
hard to be very appropriate for the solemn
occasion the bath was very full ~~very~~ ~~many~~
mostly women

Mon 4th several carpenters to work to day on the
ship. I have had rather a slack to day myself
Sund 5th employed to day in getting ready to
paint and caring of dust shavings on the 6th
employed in painting the ship's two bark sides
and on the 7th painted her counter and room
Sat 11th employed to day in fixing the deck and
ring up deck to day the Bark being fixed
up this part

Sund 12th very pleasant to day attended
church three times to day. Not the church
was not so full as the few Sabbaths passing
the 13th employed about deck. two men
I work scraping the ship's side on
the 14th my shipmate went out in the
gunboat on horse back

Thurs 14th employed to day in the
after part in dashing down the ship
it has been a steady rain all day

Thurs 15th & Fri 16th working a little in
the rigging and painting a little
and clearing up deck and various
other things on the 15th the Brig Emma
went ashore on the reef a
short distance from Simon Head perhaps
two miles to the Westward

Sat 17th this day commenced very rainy
the carpenters did not come to work
to day about 9 A.M. took a boat load
of shavings and a ship was under
