

June the 15 AD 1841

Monday the 15 comes in with light winds and calm all round the compass employed in cleaning the blackish middle part much the same but caught several dogfish latter part light breeze from S and being employed in sailing up the Niagara river mast and rudder standing in for the land so ends Lat 15-35 Long 75

Tuesday the 16 comes in with light breeze from S standing in for the port in sailance with the Mils at 5 PM the Mils anchored at the Area port as shown in the sailing and then went this and lay off shore till 4 PM middle part the Mils latter stood in shore and sent A boat in search of Arica

Wednesday the 17 comes in with fine weather in the fore and on middle part calm latter part light breeze from S and commenced sailing the Mils at 1 PM the boat came of and went ashore again so ends

Thursday the 18 comes in with light breeze from South laying of and in at night finished sailing the blackish in all 18 PM middle part light air and calm latter part light breeze from South standing in for the port so ends

Friday the 19 comes in with light breeze from South at 2 PM the boat came of and went and went right ashore again as middle part standing of shore with and English vessels latter part we were round the shore and stood of shore again so ends

June the 19 AD 1841

Saturday the 20 comes in with light breeze from South laying of and on the boat ashore two men sent away before 4 o'clock and then the white came at 5 PM the boat came of and went ashore again at night the Mils got under way stood out middle part lay of and on attended with grain latter part heard birds boats and saw the Mils more at noon came ashore again so ends at 10 PM

Sunday the 21 comes in with light breeze from S standing in for the port the Mils on our sea were standing in middle and latter part lay of the mouth of the harbour observed at noon the boat came of

Monday the 22 comes in with light breeze from S standing to the SPM middle part calm latter part light breeze from South ward at 11 AM saw packish board all 4 boats and so the boat at 2 PM the Mils boat at 3 PM boat 1 and boat 3 so ends

Tuesday the 23 comes in with light air and calm all round the compass employed in cleaning the blackish at 2 PM ward the rough boat and got another blackish the Mils astern of us the land in sight about 25 miles of middle part light air from the eastward steering to the S by S latter part light breeze from SPM steering that in company with the Mils saw plenty of finback so ends
