

July the 11 A.D. 1840

Saturday the 11 comes in with light breezes from South by the Eastward middle part of S.W. latter part saw some Whales board the second mate struck and got his boat stove at noon caught the Whales along side and set lat 13.

Sunday the 12 comes in with light breezes from South coming in cutting the Whale at right angles the boat in middle part saw by the head latter cut that saw the Balise standing at noon commenced sailing at lat 13.

Monday the 13 comes in with moderate breeze from S.E. by S.W. in evening at 4 P.M. saw 4 or 5 Bechishin Sound the sea was not so rough at mid night were ship saw 4 or 5 latter part strong breeze from S.E. employed in sailing lat 13.10

Tuesday the 14 comes in with strong breezes from S.E. at night finished sailing at lat 14.10 were ship saw S.W. middle part the same latter part top of a Whales sound latitude 14.50 long

Wednesday the 15 comes in with strong S.E. winds strong S.W. middle part saw S.W. latter part strong S.W. 50 winds latitude 14.50

July the 16 A.D. 1840

Thursday the 16 comes in with strong breezes from S.E. in North wind latter part strong S.W. latter part lat 14.50 long 81

Friday the 17 comes in with light breezes from S.W. in S.W. middle and latter part the same sound lat 14.50 long 81

Saturday the 18 comes in with light breezes from S.W. at 3 P.M. saw to ship at 4 P.M. at 9 P.M. saw a few in power of the ship saw a few in power of the ship with 18's in four minutes and 1/2 of it whole in middle part saw by latter part saw S.W. ends lat 14.50 long 81

Sunday the 19 comes in with light breezes from S.E. in company with the Swift saw some pack at 4 P.M. saw whole and ended them sperm but it being so dark we could not tell middle part saw 1 or 2 at night and 1 or 2 the latter part the same latitude 14.50 long 81

Monday the 20 comes in with strong breezes from S.E. by S.W. middle part took a few saw S.W. by S.W. latter part commenced sailing but the moon being saw a few of the pack and blew back by S.W. at ends lat 14.50 long 81
