

July the 31 AD 1840 on Peru

Friday the 31 comes in with moderate breeze from S.W. standing in shore at night saw the lighting of the lighthouse by the land of Perudo bearing S.W. distant 5 or 6 middle part foggy latter part much the same so ends

Saturday the 1 August the 1 comes in with light breeze from S.W. bearing up to Calis at night the wind being light we stood in shore and then we ran anchor in nine fathoms water with the Island of Saint Peter middle part bearing S.W. distant 10 or 12 the lighting of land bearing S.W. and the Island of Perudo bearing S.W. middle part the same latter part in danger of anchorage we took our anchor and worked her up at 10 the lighting of the lighthouse being shown up our work at 12 we anchored 1/2 cable in our former water and within one cable length of the French Brigades

Sunday the 2 comes in with light breeze from S.W. employed in cleaning ship middle part calm latter part all hands went on shore but three men in Calis so ends

August the 3 AD 1840 on Peru 21

Monday the 3 comes in with light air from South middle part the same latter part all hands came aboard commenced painting the ship several vessels came in so ends in Calis

Tuesday the 4 comes in with light air and calm middle part thick foggy latter part the same so ends

Wednesday the 5 comes in with light from South employed in painting the middle part foggy latter part much the same

Thursday the 6 comes in with light breeze from S.W. employed in painting the middle part breeze latter middle part same at 8 A.M. landed 785 gallons of sperm oil one man went ashore so ends in Calis

Friday the 7 comes in with moderate breeze from S.W. one man ashore middle part foggy latter part the same

Saturday the 8 comes in with moderate breeze from S.W. at 2 P.M. landed one barrel of sperm oil and of Blackfish middle part foggy latter part at 9 A.M. landed six barrels of Blackfish oil this day six men deserted the ship
