

July 7th 1840 in Calis

Sunday the 7 comes in with light breeze from S.W. one wash ashore middle part thick foggy weather latter the wash came ashore and the latter went ashore laying in Calis

Monday the 8 comes in with moderate breeze from S.W. middle part foggy latter not so pleasant in Calis

Tuesday the 9 comes in with moderate breeze from S.W. all hands on board except the captain and mate. Latter part quite pleasant at 8 P.M. delivered on board the Brig 200 lbs of flour and one hundred pounds of bread Calis

Wednesday the 10 comes in with moderate breeze from S.W. one wash ashore shaped like a man by the name of John, Fish as boat steward at 4 P.M. sent the boat in and brought of 20 bags of potatoes middle part foggy latter part light air and pleasant at 9 P.M. brought of 24 bags of potatoes one wash ashore laying in Calis

Thursday the 11 comes in with moderate breeze from S.W. middle part calm latter part at 8 P.M. landed 998 gallons of sperm oil one wash ashore laying in Calis

July the 14 1840

Friday the 14 comes in with light breeze from S.W. middle part calm and foggy latter part saw humpbacks, heard one boat but could not strike them at 9 P.M. brought of uncous and pumpkins so sends one wash ashore Calis

Saturday the 15 comes in with moderate breeze from S.W. middle part foggy latter part all hands on board except the mate who is discharged he not being very well

Sunday the 16 comes in with light breeze from S.W. shaped like a man middle part foggy weather latter part fine so sends in Calis

Monday the 17 comes in with moderate breeze from S.W. middle and latter part the same

Tuesday the 18 comes in with moderate breeze from S.W. middle and latter part the same so sends laying in Calis
