Thursday October the 7
this 24 hours comes in with light S & trade lay
S & E by E employed in ship duty middle
part under three top sails courses attended with
rain latter part light breeze so ends
lat 59 miles South Long 102-15

Thursday October the 8
this 24 hours comes in with moderate breeze from
S & E by E employed in ship duty saw
one fin back middle part pleasant
latter part made all sail lay N & E
ends are near sick latter course N long 100

Friday October the 9
this 24 hours comes in with light breezes from
S & E at night took in the top & main sails
tacked ship lay E by N middle part tacked
tacked ship lay S & W latter part tacked lay
E by N so ends lat 44 miles N Long 100-18

Saturday October the 10
this 24 hours comes in with light S & trade lay
S & W saw one fin back at night tacked
ship lay E by N middle part tacked ship
lay S & W latter part employed in getting
cut beef an pork and molasses so ends
latitude 40 miles South
longitude 101-25 West

Off shore ground 1840

Sunday October the 11
this 24 hours comes in with fine S & trade
S & W nothing to be seen middle part
the same latter part saw several fin
backs attended with squalls of rain
ends latitude 1-56 Long 103-16

Monday October the 12
this 24 hours comes in with light breeze
from S & E by E saw three fin back
top sails and courses middle part the
same latter part employed in ship
duty so ends latitude 3-40 Long 104-50

Tuesday October the 13
this 24 hours comes in with light breezes from
S & E lay I saw four fins and fin backs
middle part five latter part made
sail lay S by West so ends
lat 5-2 Long 105-30

Wednesday October the 14
this 24 hours comes in with strong breezes
from S & E lay I employed in ship duty
at night doubled reefed the top sails
at midnight tacked ship lay N & W
latter part tacked ship lay S & W
nothing in sight so ends
latitude 5-53 Longitude 105-50
