Friday December the 18

This 24 hours comes in with light breezes from
W. W. employed in sending the sail & middle part
and latter part the same laying in Tombo
so ends 2 men sick

Saturday December the 19

This 24 hours comes in with light breezes and
pleasant got off 35 barrels of potatoes and
50 pumpkins middle part light airs and
cloudy latter part several men went
shore with liberty so ends

Sunday December the 20

This 24 hours comes in with light breezes and
fair weather middle part the same
latter part 4 men deserted 2 boatswains
the Carpenter and Cook so ends

Monday December the 21

This 24 hours come with strong N.W. wind
and pleasant middle part the same
latter part much the same one boat
came back so ends

Tuesday December the 22

This 24 hours comes in with strong breezes and
pleasant middle part much the same latter
part calm & in boats & came to the Tombo
so ends 2 men sick

Wednesday December the 23

This 24 hours comes in with light breezes and
pleasant at 4 P.M. the boat came and board
and brought of the deserters middle part
pleasant latter part calm so ends 2 men sick

Thursday December the 24

This 24 hours comes in with light breezes and pleasant
at one P.M. weighed anchor and went to sea
at night the Sand saint Clara leaving N.E.
latter part pleasant employed in Ship's duty
so ends one man sick Latitude 3.12 S Long 89

Friday December the 25

This 24 hours comes in with moderate breezes from
W. W. employed in Ship's duty at night
lacked this day W by N middle part
the same latter part lay W. W. employed
in Ship's duty so ends one man sick
Latitude 3.59 S Long 82.40

Saturday December the 26

This 24 hours comes in with light S.E. winds
lay W. W. employed in Ship's duty at night
lacked this day East middle part the same
latter part strong breezes lay S.E. by W.
employed in Ship's duty so ends
one man sick Latitude 3.40
Longitude 81.11 W
