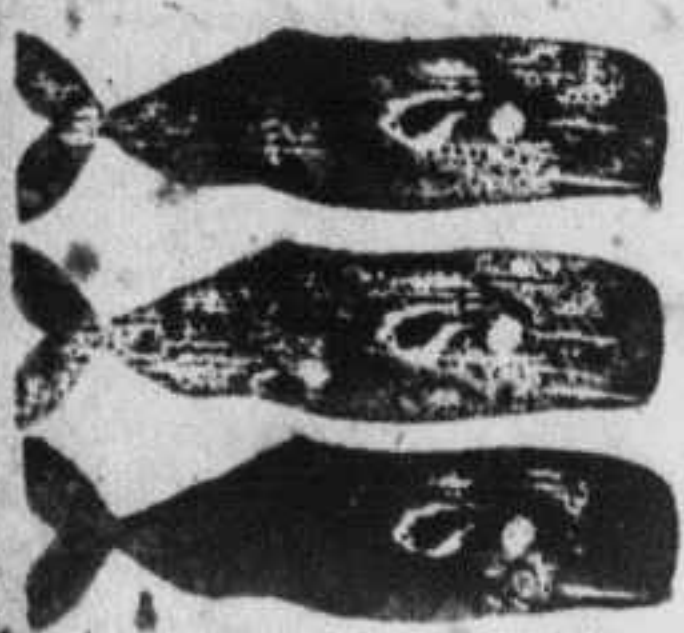


On the Coast of Peru

Sunday December the 27
This 24 hours comes in with strong breezes from S.W. lay S.E. at night saw the land back and pleasant lay S.E. gave several shots of beach. Ship lay off Port middle part much the same at 3 A.M. backed ship lay S.E. by E at 9 A.M. backed again lay W by S at noon backed back again lay S.E. by E saw the land called Cape Blanco bearing S.E. distant 30 miles so ends Latitude 4.12



Monday December the 28
This 24 hours comes in with strong winds lay S.E. by E at one P.M. saw Pierre's Whales heard three boats and got three Whales brought them along side and commenced cutting at night got one in made sail stood on shore middle part at 3 A.M. more ship at daylight wore back again lay S.E. commenced cutting the Whales at 8 A.M. finished saw the land bearing S.E. distant 20 miles so ends one more Latitude 4.50

Tuesday December the 29
This 24 hours comes in with strong S.W. winds lay West all hands employed in cleaning the deck at night finished and commenced boiling middle part employed in boiling latter part the same saw one ship so ends one more sick Latitude 4.12 Longitude 8.12

Wednesday December the 30
This 24 hours comes in with a fine breeze from S.W. lay S.E. gave several shots of beach middle part finished boiling at 7 A.M. spoke the Parker so ends Latitude 5.12

Thursday December the 31
This comes in with light winds and pleasant at 3 P.M. spoke the Baltic Gardner Nantucket with 800 lbs 16 months out middle part steering down for Paitia at daylight in sight of the town at 8 A.M. one boat went on shore ship laying off and on so ends one man sick

Friday December

Friday January the 1 1842
This 24 hours comes in with strong southerly winds laying off and on in company with the Parker at night the boat came on board with one bag of Cocoa and five barrels of provisions middle part standing off shore latter part stood in at 9 A.M. sent the boat ashore so ends laying off Patya Harbour one man sick
