Wednesday February the 3

This 24 hours comes in with light N.E. breezes
lay V.P. employed in felling middle part
much the same latter part finished so ends
Latitude 7.12 Longitude 93.40

Thursday February the 4

This 24 hours comes in with light breezes from N.E.
lay S.E. & middle part the same latter part
employed in Ship's duty, wind N.E. lay S.E. &
so ends Latitude 6.52 Longitude 92.20

Friday February the 5

This 24 hours comes in with light N.E. trades lay S.E.
employed in Ship's duty middle part light
breezes lay East latter part the same employed in
coopering oil men such so ends Latitude 6.31 Long 91.50

Saturday February the 6

This 24 hours comes in with light N.E. trades lay S.E.
employed in Ship's duty middle part calm
latter part employed in stowing down oil at noon
finished so ends all hands well

Latitude 6.32 Longitude 90.50

Sunday February the 7

This 24 hours comes in with light breezes all round the
compass employed in coopering great middle part
light breezes from Northward lay N.E. by N
latter part the same so ends

Latitude 6.58 Longitude 88.20

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Monday February the 8

This 24 hours comes in with light breezes and
pleasant lay V.P. middle part lay V.P.
latter part employed in Ship's duty wind N.E.
lay S.E. & so ends Latitude 7.28 Longitude 86.85

Tuesday February the 9

This 24 hours comes in with light N.E. trades and
pleasant lay S.E. & middle part much the same
latter part employed in felling rigging
so ends Latitude 7.45 Longitude 86.40

Wednesday February the 10

This 24 hours comes in with light airs and calm
sheering N.E. employed in felling rigging
middle part calm latter part much the
same so ends Latitude 7.54 Longitude 85.50

Thursday February the 11

This 24 hours comes in with light breezes from
Westward sheering S.E. & employed in felling
rigging middle part the same latter
part at 7 A.M. saw sperm whales going
quick to wind round down three boats
but could not catch them at came aboard
took up our boat at 10 A.M. lost sight
of them to windward S.E. of East again
so ends Latitude 8.15 Long 84.55
