Friday February the 12

This 24 hours comes in with light breezes from the Northward employed in fitting rigging for the Northward employed in hoisting at night shorter sail sheer East middle part light breezes steering & latter part the same cross land bearing North and N. in hoisting so ends Lat 6.49 Long 82.00 men sick

Saturday February the 13

This 24 hours comes in with light breezes from the Northward employed in this duty middle part light breezes from the Northward latter part calm at 10 A.M. saw 3 sperm whales heard all 4 boats and each struck so ends in sight off Cedroner Islands so ends bearing N. 80 E. 10 miles

Sunday February the 14

This 24 hours came in with light breeze from the Northward employed in getting the whales to the ship at 3 P.M. brought three whales along side



employed in cutting at night finished cutting one middle part by the throat latter part commenced cutting at night finished cutting the big whale lost one fluke chain by the carelessness of the crew so ends men sick

Latitude 6.56 Longitude 82.21

Monday February the 15

This 24 hours comes in with strong East by winds employed in cutting at night finished cutting more ship lay North middle part lay N with the mainyard at hoisting latter part the same latitude 6.49 Long 82.00 men sick

Bound for Quibo in year 1841

Tuesday February the 16

This 24 hours comes in with light breezes and calm from the Northward employed in hoisting at night in sight of Quibo middle part squally latter part more moderate employed in hoisting so ends Lat 6.49 Long 82.00 men sick

Wednesday February the 17

This 24 hours comes in with light air from East lay N employed in hoisting at night finished hoisting 100 lbs middle part calm latter part light breezes from East lay North so ends Latitude 6.55 Longitude 82.20

Thursday February the 18

This 24 hours comes in with light breeze and calm from the Northward middle part calm latter part light breeze from N. E. lay N employed in coopers oil so ends Lat 6.33 Long 82.00

Friday February the 19

This 24 hours comes in with light breezes from East steering N. N. E. at night finished coopers oil saw the Island of Libo bearing N. N. E. 10 miles middle part light breezes latter part employed in hoisting at 9 A.M. saw 3 sperm whales at 11 heard three boats be made struck and the Iron broke struck again took the Iron the second time the second mate struck two and saved them both so end Quibo bearing N. distant 40 miles
