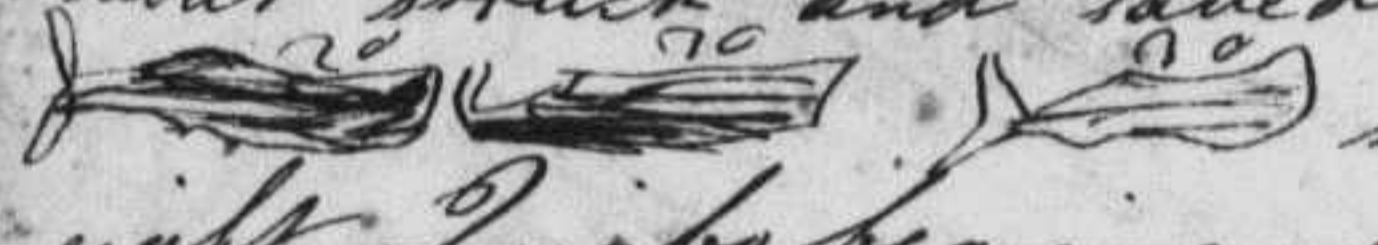


Cruising off Lays to in year 1841

Saturday February the 20
This 24 hours comes in with strong breezes from
N.E. in chase of whales. at 5 P.M. brought
the Whales along side and put off after
more at dead struck two darts from one
and cut from the other came aboard
bark spoke the Frances off New Bedford
Benard Mast. also the Guilermic off
Tahuanana with 300 lbs Simons mast
middle part lay by the Whales latter part
cut them in so ends Quibo bearing N.W. distant
30 miles



Sunday February the 21
This 24 hours comes in with light breezes from
shering by N at 4 P.M. took in the bow boat
employed in boiling middle part the same latter
part light breezes at 4 P.M. saw 4 whales off
Sperr Whales board all four boats at each
boat struck and saved the whales
so end three ships in
sight Quibo bearing N.W. distant 35 miles



Monday February the 22
This 24 hours comes in with light breezes from
Westward employed in getting the Whales along
at 11 P.M. got them along side and commenced
cutting at night finished cutting two of them
got supper at the watch employed in boiling
latter part employed in cutting the other that
finished made sail shered. N.W. distant so ends
Quibo bearing North distant 25 miles

Cruising off Lays to in year 1841

Tuesday February the 23
This 24 hours light breezes and calm employed
in boiling so end Quibo bearing N.W. distant 35 miles

Wednesday February the 24
This 24 hours comes in with light airs and calm
Captain Howland and Off Simons both on
board at 4 P.M. saw 4 Whales of Sperr Whales
board all four boats struck and drew middle
and latter part boiling so ends Point Mary
Quibo bearing N.W. distant 45 miles

Thursday February the 25
This 24 hours comes in with light airs and calm
at 2 P.M. finished boiling spoke the Guilermic
Tahuanana middle and latter part employed
in cooping oil so ends Point Maryetta bearing
North distant 45 miles

Friday February the 26
This 24 hours comes in with light breezes from
bearing N.W. distant middle part struck the same
latter part employed in cooping oil at 4 P.M.
saw Sperr Whales at 10 P.M. board four boats
and Point Maryetta bearing N.W. distant 30 miles

Saturday February the 27
more the same
