

Bound for Cocoss Island

April the 2 comes in with light southerly winds steering West, employed in fitting rigging, middle part, the same latter part, light breezes, Latitude 6.40 Long 83.10
Saturday the 3, attended with light breezes, steering West by South, Latitude 6.50 Longitude 82.18
Sunday the 4 comes in with light S.E. winds, steering W by N, in company with the New England - middle part, and latter part much the same Mountain bearing N distant 20 miles, Monday April the 5 comes in with light S.W. winds steering N.W. in company with the New England - middle part much the same, Mountain bearing N, distant 20 miles, latter part, steering N.W. Mountain bearing N, distant 20 miles, Tuesday the 6 comes in with light southerly winds, course N.W. West, middle part the same, latter part steering West, employed in fitting rigging, Mountain bearing N.W. distant 35 miles, for the last 10 days we have had the current setting to the S.E., that we gain but little to the westward - Wednesday the 7 comes in with light southerly winds steering West, in company with the New England middle part much the same, latter part strong southerly winds steering W by S, so ends, Latitude 7.5 Longitude 83.15 - Thursday the 8 comes in with strong southerly winds, steering W by S in company with the New England, this day being West with a good breeze, and fair current we make out to loose sight of Mountain after steering, as direct from it as possible for these days, middle and latter part steering West, so ends - Latitude 7.40 Longitude 84.40
Friday the 9 comes in with strong southerly winds, course West, middle and latter part the same - so ends, Latitude 8 Longitude 85

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Saturday April the 10, comes in with light breezes from S.W. steering West, middle part, lay N.W. West, latter part, packed ship, lay S.W. so ends - Latitude 7.50 Longitude 85.6 by chronometer
Sunday the 11 comes in with light breezes and cloudy weather, making S.W. West course, so ends, Latitude 7.12 Longitude 86.6
Monday April the 12 Mid 24 hours comes in with light breezes from S.W. steering S.W. middle part, course S.W. West, in company with the New England, at 10 A.M. we saw the shore of Spermin Whales, board three boats and give chase, but they being shy we could not catch them at noon, give up the chase, and came aboard, took up our boat, and kept our course, so ends - Latitude 6.18 Longitude 86.20
Tuesday the 13 comes in with light N.W. wind steering S.W. at 1 P.M. saw Cocoss Island bearing S.W. West, and run for it, middle part lay off the Island, latter part the Captain, went on shore at 11 A.M. came aboard again, and sent two boats in with casks for water.
at abundance in wood and water, wild hogs are found here, and on S.E. side of the Island coconuts, are found in great plenty, Wednesday being the 14th the first part we get off fifty barrels of water, middle and latter part moderate breezes from S.W. lay S.W. saw the ship to weather off the Island, so ends - the Island bearing S.E. distant 5 leagues - Thursday the 15 comes in with light breeze at night, spoke the Elizabeth off London, Capt. Bunker, with 800 barrels 15 months out middle and latter part garning with
