 Friday May the 13, comes in with light
 E. by S winds, lay S. E., employed in Ship duty
 at night doubled reefed middle part, at 12
 A. M. wore Ship, lay N. N. E., at daylight, wore
 lay West, attended with rain, last part, made sail
 Steered S. W., so, end, Latitude 31.30, Longitude 178.40
 Saturday May the 14, comes in with, brisk breeze
 from Northward, steering S. W. at night shortened
 sail, middle part, lay S. E., under, double, reef
 maintop sail, and fore sail, latter part made sail
 lay S. E., so ends, Latitude 30.47, Longit 179.18 East
 Sunday the 15 comes in with strong N. E. winds
 lay S. E., middle part lay S. E., under double reef
 maintop sail, and fore sail, latter part made
 sail, steered S. by S., so ends, Lat 29.8 Long 177.25
 Monday the 16 comes in with strong E. by S.
 winds, steering S. by S., middle part lay S. E.
 under double reef maintop sail, and fore sail, latter
 part made sail steered S. W. by S., so ends
 Latitude 27.37, Longitude 177.30, by Chrono
 and 178.05, by Lunars,
 Tuesday May the 17, comes in with strong
 E. by S. winds, steering S. W. by S., employed in
 Ship duty, at night shortened sail, middle
 part, lay S. by E., latter part made sail, course
 N. N. E., so ends, Latitude 27.10 Longitude by Chrono
 176.30. E., 177.12. Longit
 Wednesday May the 18 comes in with light E. by S.
 winds steering N. N. West, middle part, lay N. N. E.
 under double reef topsails, latter part made all
 sail, steering N. W., employed in fitting the
 jibboom rigging so ends Latitude 27.29

 Thursday May the 19
 comes in with light airs and calm (course)
 N. N. E., employed in Ship duty, middle part
 calm, latter part the same as the first
 end, Latitude 28.19, Long 177.00

Friday May the 20, comes in with
 light air from Southward, and pleasant
 course N. N. E., employed in Ship duty
 middle part, lay E., with topsails on the cap - last
 part made all sail steered N. E. by N., so ends
 Latitude 29.05 Long 177.15

Saturday May 21
 comes in with with a fine S. by E. winds, course
 N. E., employed in Ship duty, middle part
 lay East, under double reef topsail, latter
 part made sail steered N. E., so ends
 Lat 28.51 - Longitude 178.40 East

Sunday May 22
 this day comes in with light E. by S. winds
 steering N. E., employed in fitting the burning
 lathe, at night had a shower of rain, doubled
 reefed the topsails, middle part lay N. E. by E.
 latter part made all sail, lay East so ends
 Lat 29.05 Longitude 179.49 E

Monday May the 23
 begins with moderate breeze from N. E., lay
 S. E., at night shortened sail - middle
 part lay N. West, latter part made sail lay N. N. E.,
 so ends

Latitude 29.25, Longitude 179.15
