

Japan 1842
Friday September the 23, begins with light
NE winds, lay by. Middle part
lay N West, latter part more ship, lay East,
so ends - Latitude 29.25 Long 179.19
Saturday September the 24

comes in with strong
NE gales, lay by. saw several finbacks
at night, more ship, double reefed the topsail
lay N by West, middle part strong gales, took
in the fore topsail, latter part strong gales, lay
N by West, so ends, Latitude 29.50 Long 179.50
Sunday September the 25,

commences with strong gales
from NE lay N by W, at night set close reef for
topsail, middle part, strong gales, lay N by W
latter part much the same, so ends -
Latitude 30.50 Long 180.20

Monday September 26
comes in with strong gales lay N by W
set mainsail and jib lay N by W
at night more ship, lay by N, middle part
much the same, latter part strong gales, lay
East, so ends, Latitude 30.44 Longitude 179.44
Tuesday September the 27,

comes in with strong
gales, lay East under double reef mainsail
and foresail, middle part strong
gales, latter part the same, so ends -
Latitude 30.17 Longitude 178.30

Wednesday September the 28
begins with strong gales
lay East, at night more ship, saw two other ships, middle part
more moderate, latter part fine, saw sperm whale, heard much noise
the close by, found out the other, Lat 30.17 Long 178.50

Japan 1842
Thursday September the 29, begins with moderate
winds, got the whale along side commenced cutting
at night got him in, middle part boiling, latter
part at sperm whale, heard three boat the
low boat got him, at 9 AM, got him along side
so ends, Latitude 30.00 Long 178.58

Friday September the 30 -
comes in with strong
breezes from NE, commenced cutting the whale
at night finished, middle part boiling,
latter part the same, so ends - Latitude 30.00
Longitude 179.40

Sunday October the 1
begins with light breezes from NE, lay N by W
boiling, at 2 PM, finished boiling 55 barrels
middle part fine, latter part made all
sail lay N by W, so ends, three men sick, two
with the scurvy, Latitude 31.05 Long 179.49
Sunday October the 2,

comes in with light
winds and fine, lay N by W, at 2 PM, spoke
Elizabeth of Salem, we made out 550 barrels
middle part lay by, latter part much the
same, so ends, Lat 31.20 Longitude 179.26
Monday October the 3

attended with NNE winds
and pleasant weather - lay by, our consort to
the leeward of us, middle part fine, latter
part made all sail, and commenced stowing
down the oil, so ends, Latitude 30.53
Longitude 178.50
