breeze, employ in drawing yarns, middle part
raining latter part the same, so ends

Wednesday January the 1
February the 1

begins with light
breezes and rains middle and latter part
same, so ends, one man sick -

Thursday February the 2

comes in with light
breezes and pleasant weather, employed in
making spungarn, middle part fine latter
part employed in Ships duty, so ends -

Friday February the 3

attended with light West
winds, employed in making, new Abizon
rigger, so ends -

Saturday February the 4

comes in with light breeze, and pleasant weather,
employed in Ships duty, so end -

Sunday February the 5

begins with light southerly wind, employed in
calking, ship out side, middle part, fine,
latter part, the same

Monday February the 6

begins with light westerly winds, all hands
shore, middle part fine, latter part, the same

Tuesday February the 7

comes in with light breeze, two
Ships came in, at 2 PM, took the Abizon mast
board and stowed it, middle part, fine
latter part employed in Ship duty, so ends

Wednesday February the 8

comes in with light
breezes and pleasant weather, employed in
Ships duty, so ends

Thursday February the 9

attended with light breezes, Employed
in Ships duty middle, and latter part fine

Friday February the 10

light breezes and pleasant
weather employed in Ships duty, so ends

Saturday February the 11

comes in with breezes
and pleasant weather employed in Ships duty

Sunday February the 12

comes with strong southerly
winds, middle part and latter part raining,
so ends, latter part, whiped a black man by the name of decker for
his name, Monday February the 13

comes in with light
breezes and rains middle part raining, latter
part the Captain at board, and put the
sails in the rigging again, and whiped him

remainder part employed in Ships duty,
so ends

Tuesday February the 14

comes in with light breezes, and pleasant weather,
employed in Ship duty, at 4 PM took 8 hundred
cwt of water on board, at 5 the Sloop of War

came down to the bar and anchored
middle part fine latter part employed in
Ships duty, the bottom came in side

so ends, three men sick
