

Sandwich Island, 1843

Saturday March the 4

begins with light breeze and calm. Heavens brown in sight middle part at 1 P.M. came to anchor in 17 fathoms water, latter part, fine weather so ends. The mate very sick, and one of the men

Sunday March the 5

comes in with light S.W. winds, middle part the same, latter part, the most of the men on shore so ends

Monday March the 6

attended with light S.W. wind and haze - so ends. The Mate, and four of the hands, sick

Tuesday March the 7

attended with light S.W. breeze, and light showers of rain, Wednesday March the 8

attended with light S.W. winds, got of 16 barrels of potatoes - latter part breasting the foretop sail, so ends

Thursday March the 9

begins with light breeze from S.E. sent the fore top sail, latter part got of a few potatoes, so ends

Friday March the 10

attended with light breeze, so ends. The Mate and four men sick, and the Doctor says we can't go till Monday

Saturday March the 11

attended with strong N.W. winds, the Despatch and Ocean sail, one hour South and the other South, so ends. The Mate convalescent, for men sick

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Sunday March the 12

begins with strong N.W. winds one man on shore, so ends

Monday March the 13

attended with light S.W. breeze, latter part. The Mate, not getting any better we were obliged to take him on shore, to stop a few days. - four men sick, so ends

Tuesday March the 14

comes in with light S.W. winds, at 2 P.M. take our anchor, bound for Porpoose again, to land Miss Colcord, she being near her end. latter part, saw Porpoose, 2 men sick -

Wednesday March the 15

attended with strong gale from S.W. lay off & on at Porpoose, saw the Cheiroit, London (small) last stood of shore, latter part stood back for Mowee, so ends, four men sick

Thursday March the 16

comes in with strong S.W. winds, at 2 P.M. the ship went on shore at Mowee, at night returned and back for Porpoose, middle and latter part light breeze, so ends four men sick

Friday March the 17

comes in with light N.W. winds, lay off & on middle part lay off of Dymona head latter part ran in off Honolulu town, and landed Miss Colcord, so ends -

the Mate in Mowee sick, four men sick besides
