

Sandwich Islands 1843.

Saturday March the 18

comes in with light S.W. winds, laying off and on at Porhoo middle part attended with heavy squalls of wind and rain, latter part more moderate the boat went on shore, so ends

Sunday March the 19

begins with light E.S.W. winds, discharged, & boat officer by the name of Davis, at night the Captain came on board, & middle and latter part, steering for the Islands of Moraki, Rani, and the Vir night, so ends

Monday March the 19 comes in with light E.S.W. winds, beating up for Mowee, at 2 P.M. passed the Ship Tharua, middle part at 11 P.M. dropped our anchor in 17 fathoms water, of Kahini, rain latter part fine, so ends

Tuesday March the 20 light breeze and calm, so ends

Wednesday March the 21

begins with light breezes from Southward, latter part strong gales from North ward, employed in clearing ship, so ends

Thursday March the 22

begins with strong Northely gale, latter part pleasant took on board 21 barrels of meat, and 10 cask of stock, so ends

Friday March the 23 attended with light breezes, employed in ship duty latter part, got an old boat, employed in ship duty

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Saturday March the 25

begins with strong Northely winds, employed in ship duty at got 5 cask of stock on board, middle part fine, latter part, much the same, so ends

Sunday March the 26

attended with light breeze, latter part one wreck on shore, so ends

Monday March the 27

light breeze and shear one wreck on shore, so ends

Tuesday March the 28

comes in with strong with strong breeze and overcast, employed in ship duty, so ends

Wednesday March the 29 comes in with strong breezes from N.W. part getting off recruits, middle part fine

latter part at the first, so ends

Thursday ~~Wednesday~~ March the 30

attended with light breeze, getting off potatoes, so ends

Friday March the 31

light breeze and calm middle part over cast, latter part much the same, shipped & boatstewer by the name of Joseph Antone, so ends

Saturday

April the 1

comes in with light S.W. winds, at 2 P.M. after having what things we want, we take our anchor once more from Mowee, and shape our course for Porhoo, latter part Porhoo in sight, so ends
