Saturday April the 15

begins with light trades
and pleasant weather, mending sail,
middle part fine, latter part much the same
made all sail, lay North, so ends. Lat 28.41
Long 165.30 five men sick

Sunday April the 16
comes in with light breeze and pleasant
weather, middle part calm, latter
part light Southerly winds steering NE, saw
one pinback, so ends, four men sick,
Latitude 29.45. Longitude 165.57. Rest

Monday April the 17
comes in with light airs and
calm, steering NE, middle part fine
latter part steering ENE, employed in
mending sails, so ends. four men sick,
Longitude 165.00 Longitude 165.00

Tuesday April the 18
begins with light breezes
from Southward steering ENE, employed
in mending sail, middle part course ENE,
latter part course NE, employed in Ship
duty, so ends. Latitude 30.55 Longitude 162.20

Wednesday April the 19
comes in with light Partly
winds steering NE, employed in Ship duty, middle
part attended with light showers of rain. Latter
part fine lay East, so ends Lat 31.57 Long 161.90

Thursday April the 20 begins
with light
NE winds lay ENE, A heavy swell running, employed
in stowing up shooks, middle part fine lay ENE,
latter part heaved Ship lay North, so ends
Lat 32.15 Long 161.00

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Friday April the 21

comes in with light NE winds
by North employed setting up shooks, saw 1 Ship
to leeward, middle part fine, latter part
employed in setting up shooks, so ends
Long by Lunar, 59.29. by Chrono 159.09, Latitude 31.55

Saturday April the 22
comes in with light SE
winds & steering NE by N, setting up shooks,
middle part double reefed the topsails, latter
part course NE by N, fresh gales from Southward
so ends, Lat 32.25. Long by Lunar, 159.49. by Ch 159.20

Sunday April the 23
begins with strong gales from Southward
course NE by N, middle part and latter
attended with rain, course NNE, so ends
Latitude 35.00 Longitude 156.00 D. H.

Monday April the 24
comes in with strong Southerly
winds and rainy weather - at night the wind
hauled to the Westward; and very light with
A heavy swell on, double reefed our topsails
middle part fine, latter part fine westerly
winds, but cold, course NNE, employed
in Ship duty, so ends, Latitude 36.55 Long 152.30

Tuesday April the 25
begins with light westerly winds
steering NNE, saw one Ship, middle part
fine, latter part employed in Ship duty, so ends
Lat 38.25 Long 152.11

Wednesday April the 26
begins with light Partly winds, middle
part course ENE, latter part steered North,
employed in Ship duty, so ends. 3 men sick
Latitude 38.25 Long 151.45
