

Bound North 1843
Thursday April the 27.

comes in with light Westly wind
employed in making a new fly jib,
middle part steering SNE, latter part steering
N by E, employed in Ship duty, at noon
picked up a large log of wood, so ends
2 men sick, Latitude 48.50, Long 149.47

Friday April the 28

begins with fresh gales from
Westward steering N by E, employed in Ship duty,
middle part out-cast, latter part much the
same, so ends, 2 men sick, Latitude 48.13

Saturday April the 29,

Long 148.28

comes in with light
Westly winds, lay North, saw finbacks, middle
part steering NNE, latter part made all
sail steering N by West, attended with light showers
of rain, so ends, Latitude 48.33, Longitude 148.50

Sunday April the 30,

begin with strong SE winds
and rain steering N by West, at night double
reefed the top sail, middle part lay West,
latter part, lay N by E, wind NNE, and rain
Monday April the

begins with strong gales from NE, lay N by E,
under close reef top sail, middle part lay North,
latter part steered N by West, so ends
2 men sick

Bound North 1843
Tuesday May the 2.

begins with light Westly winds
steering N by W, middle part, calm, latter
part light air from Southward steering
North, so ends, 2 men sick, Latitude 45.39
Longitude 147.14

Wednesday May the 3,
comes in with strong breezes from S by E,
steering N, employed in Ship duty, middle
part strong gales steering N by W, latter
part made all sail, steered North, at 11.
A.M. spoke the Margaret Scot, Smith, N.B.,
8 months out 800, so ends - two men sick
Lat 48.01 Longitude 145.45.

Thursday May the 4
begins with light breezes from S by E, steering
N by N, middle part steering, NNE,
latter part much the same, attended with
rain so ends, two men sick, Latitude 49.20
Longitude 146.30

Friday May the 5

begins with strong Southely winds
steering North, at 4 P.M. saw 12 Right Whales
lowered for them, the Thist boat struck one
and parted the line, came on board
middle part lay SE, latter part, steered
NNE, so ends, Lat 51.00, Long 147.00

Saturday May the 6

comes in with strong breeze from SE
at a P.M. saw 12 whales lowered but got nothing
it raining blowing so hard, at night came
down to close reef main top sail, and foresail, middle
part lay SE, latter part made sail, steered NNW, so ends
Lat 52.11, Long 145.40
