Friday May the 25.

begins with light airs, lay S.E., employed in mending the boat, middle part & latter part saw five Whales - lowered three boats, the mate got along side of one but the boat skinned did not last, galled them came on board, so ends, four men sick, Latitude 53-20. Long 151-50

Saturday May the 26

comes in with light westerly winds lay S.E., saw five Whales - lowered again, but could not catch them, attended with light showers of rain, at middle part lay S.W. under double reefed main top sail & foresail, latter part made all sail, at 5 P.M. saw a Whale and lowered, but could not catch him, came on board, so ends, Lat. 53-3. Long 152. 00 four men sick

Sunday May the 27

begins with light breezes, lay S.E., employed in mending the boat, middle part lay N.W. under short sail, latter part made sail lay S.W. at 8 P.M. saw a Ship, at 10 spoke the Averick Henrich Brimen 8 months out too; so ends - four men sick, Latitude 52-45 - Long 152 --

Monday May the 29.

comes in with strong N.W. wind, lay N.E. in company with the above mentioned Ship, saw a White Whale, middle part five, latter part made sail, saw a White Whale lowered but with out success, so ends - four men sick, Latitude 53-03 Long 151

Tuesday May the 30

begins with strong breezes in chase of Whales, at 6 P.M. the first boat struck one, at 11 P.M. got the Whale along side, middle part lay by the Whale, latter part at 8 P.M. commenced cutting the Whale, so ends, Latitude 52. 55, Long 149. 30 four men sick

Wednesday May the 31

comes in with light breezes from N.W., at 9 P.M. finished cutting the Whale at night spoke the Clairiot, Littlefield, middle part five, latter part commenced boiling, saw the Ann. Mary Ann, cutting a Whale, so saw one Whale and lowered but without success, so ends four men sick, Lat 52. 52. Long 150, 20

Thursday June the 1

begins with light N.W. winds, lay N.W. at 8 P.M. saw a Whale lowered but no luck middle part, boiling - latter part calm, so ends - four men sick Lat 52. 56. Long 150

Friday June the 2.

comes in with light westerly winds employed in boiling, middle part and latter much the same, so ends - Latitude 53- Long 149

Saturday June the 3

begins with light airs and calm at 4 P.M. finished boiling, saw Whales, lowered three boats, but he was going quick, middle part calm, latter part lay N.W. so ends Latitude 53-00 Long 149.

Sunday June the 4

comes in with light airs, spoke the Ann. Mary, Ann. Pinton at 6 P.M. saw a Whale going quick, middle part calm, latter part saw Whales lowered but without success, so ends, saw the Ann. Mary, Ann. Pinton, spoke a Whale. Lat 53-00 Long 151-30
