

Northwest 1843

Monday June the 5

begins with light Northerly winds, lay P.M. N. saw Phales going quick, middle part light breeze latter part, commenced stowing down oil, at noon saw a dead Phale and took him to the ship, so ends, Lathe 54.30 Long 150.30

Tuesday June the 6

comes in with strong S.W. winds, employed in cutting the Phale, at night finished but lost the head, meat part boiling, latter part the same, saw several ship, and plenty of turn back, saunders, three men sick, Lathe 54.10. Long 151

Wednesday June the 7

comes in with strong gales from P.N.E. at 1 P.M. spoke the Indian Chief - - - saw several other ships, at 4 P.M. took in the fore and Mizzen topsails and put out the fiers, at 8 close reefed the Main; lay S.E. sterned with rain, middle strong gales and, rainy, latter part more moderate sat gable reef topsails, and began boiling again thick foggy weather, so ends, three men sick Lathe 53.20 Long 150.57

Thursday June the 8

begins with strong breeze from S.E. lay South thick fog and rain, at night finished boiling, wore ship lay E.N.E. - middle part foggy, latter part made sail sterned N.E. at 11 P.M. spoke the ship Liverpool, Hancock 11 months out 900 lbs, so ends three men sick, Lathe 54.00 Long 150.15

Friday June the 9

begins with strong breezes steering N.E. by N. - at night took in the mizen topsail - middle part strong gales took in the fore and main latter part saw plenty of Phales, but has rugged to lower, commenced stowing down oil so ends, three men sick, Lathe 54.15. Long 148.50

Saturday June the 10

comes in with light breezes and thick weather at night finished stowing down 50 lbs. of oil, middle and latter part rainy, at 1 P.M. spoke the Komand, Barker, 11 months out 800 at 11 spoke the Liverpool, again, so ends, Lathe 54.30 - Long 148.00

Sunday June the 11

comes in with thick foggy weather, lay South middle part light breezes latter part foggy so ends, Lathe 54.15. Long 150.20

Monday June the 12

begins with light E.S.W. winds saw Phales, lowered twice, at night rainy, took in sail middle part and latter, thick weather, lay North, so ends - three men sick, Lat 54.45. Long 151

Tuesday June the 13

begins with strong breeze, from East, and rainy, lay North, at night wore ship P.E. by E, middle part and latter, thick, weather so ends, Lathe 54.00 Long 151.30

Wednesday June the 14

comes in with light gales, but thick, lay S.E. under double reef Main topsail and Foresail - middle part light breezes, and heavy, latter part at 11 P.M. saw a Phale, lowered three boats - so ends, Lathe 54.12 Long 151.45
